



Michigan State University Extension's Transformation Through PEARS

Michigan State University (MSU) Extension encountered major hurdles with their former planning and reporting system. Norma Lundeen, MSU Extension's Planning and Reporting Project Manager, noted that one of the biggest pain points was the system's inability to export data effectively. On top of that, inconsistent terminology across the organization made it difficult to collaborate and produce accurate reports.

"Staff often used different terms to describe the same processes, which led to confusion and slowed things down," Norma explained. "Without standardized reporting, it was tough to coordinate efforts internally and align with other extension services."

Adopting PEARS helped MSU Extension tackle these challenges directly. The new system offered several key improvements:
