



Transforming Program Evaluation and Storytelling with PEARS

University of Nebraska - Lincoln's Cooperative Extension service faced a major challenge: tracking and communicating the impact of over 11,000 distinct activities while presenting a unified message to stakeholders. As they looked ahead, they needed a solution that was both powerful and adaptable to their evolving needs.

Beyond storytelling, the system fostered a culture of intentional planning and collaboration. By centralizing data entry and incorporating tools like QR codes for participant surveys, Nebraska Extension reduced duplication and streamlined data collection—freeing up time for frontline work.
