



# Simplifying Reporting, Boosting Confidence: Delaware's PEARS Journey

The University of Delaware Extension needed a new data management system after its previous platform shut down. The old system was not user-friendly and made reporting burdensome for Extension Agents and Specialists. This led to delayed reporting, user frustration, and a heavy administrative load to ensure data was entered correctly and on time.

## What UD Extension Needed

University of Delaware Extension sought a solution that could simplify and streamline reporting, improve user experience, and encourage timely data entry. Their key priorities included:

- A system that was intuitive and easy to navigate
- A visually consistent interface to build user confidence
- Streamlined reporting workflows to reduce burden
- Increased adoption and timely reporting from staff
- Reliable support and ongoing improvements
- Opportunities for customization to fit state-specific needs
